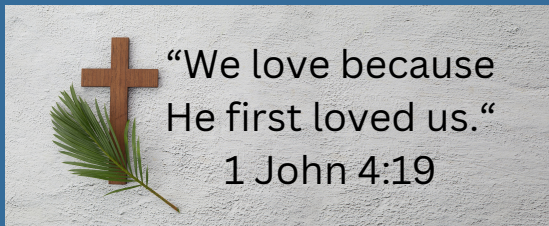

A \$7,500 Gift of Adoption grant, made possible by the STG Foundation, enabled them to travel to and live the required 4 months in Ghana to complete Bismark's adoption. Q. What is the easiest way for me to give?

A. The easiest way to donate is by visiting our website www.stgfoundation.org and clicking on the "Donate" button, which will direct you to our giving baskets page. In this page you can find your cause and allocate how you would like your contribution to be distributed.
